What speaks loudly is the way in which you live your faith—the way you handle challenges, deal with difficult people, uphold Christian values such as honesty and moderation, and give God the credit for your successes.

So when you are focusing all your attention on your goal of becoming that artist, doctor, lawyer, pilot, full-time missionary, or whatever it is, always remember to manifest His love for others. Then God can use you in ways that you may have never thought possible to help others know His great love for them. The sky's the limit—unless you want to be an astronaut. Then . . . who knows?
