One fine morning when Fred Gardener arrived in his garden to work, he noticed something was wrong.



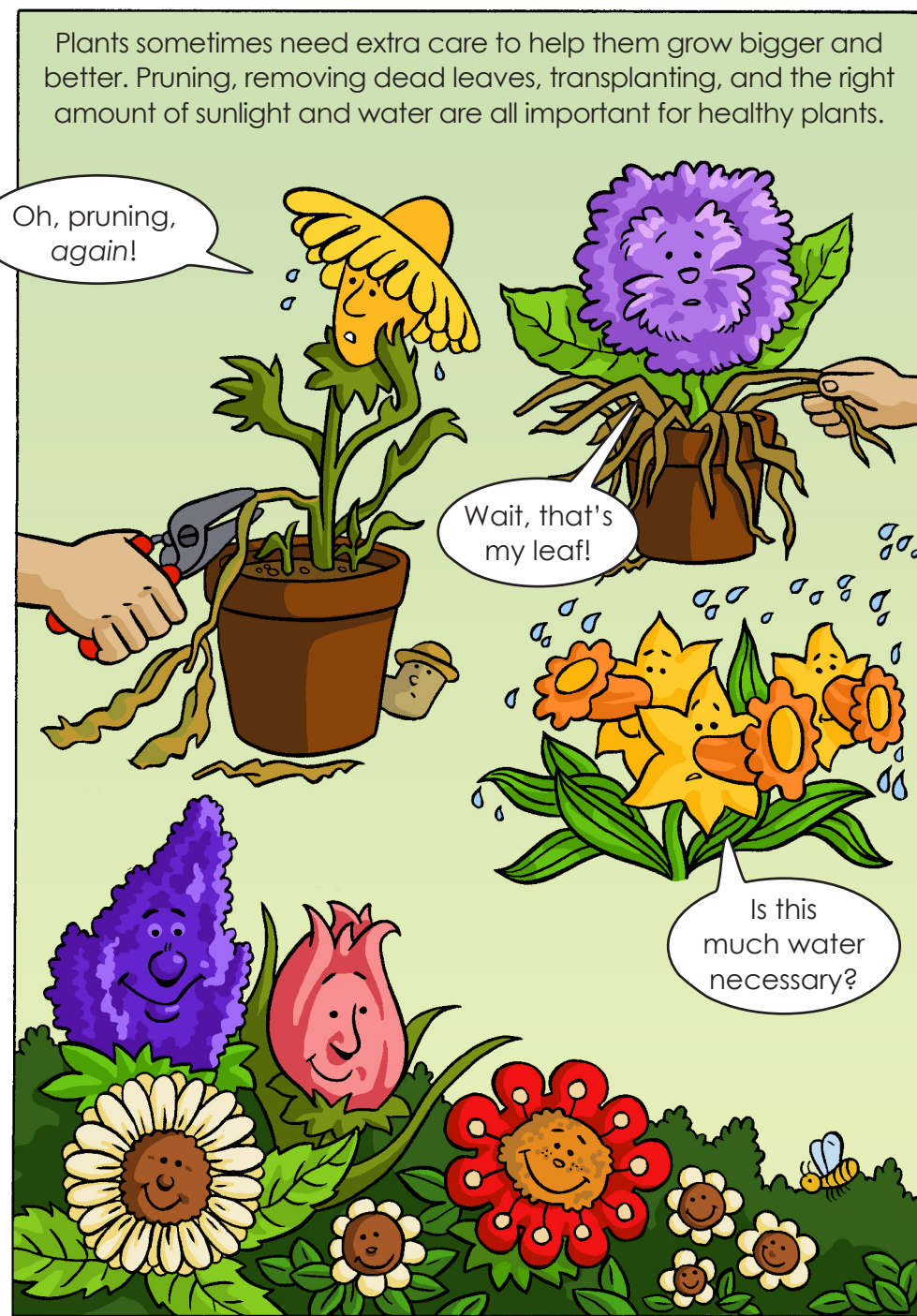

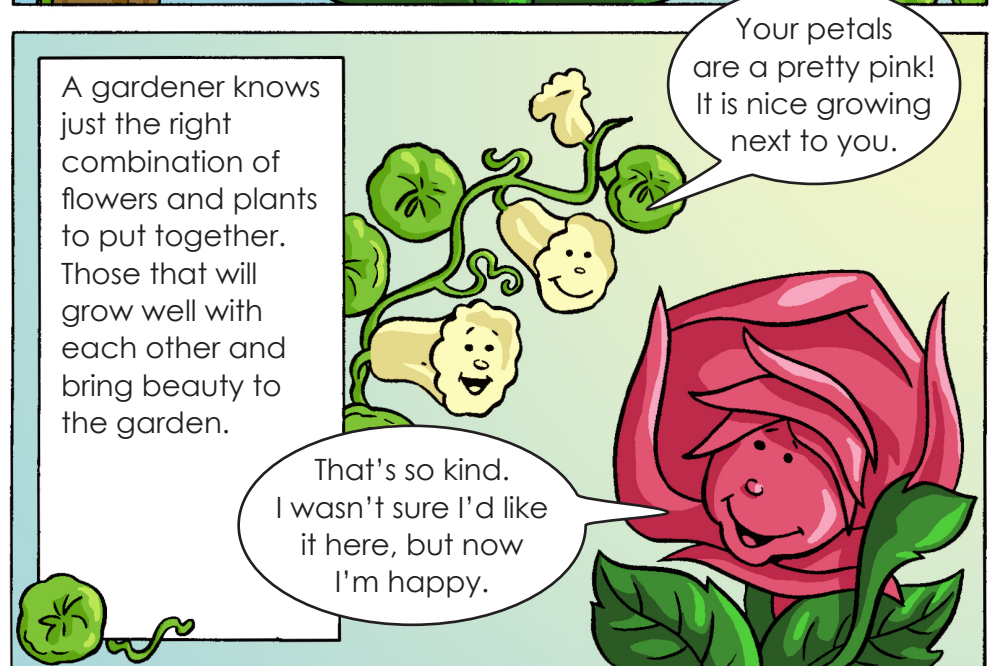
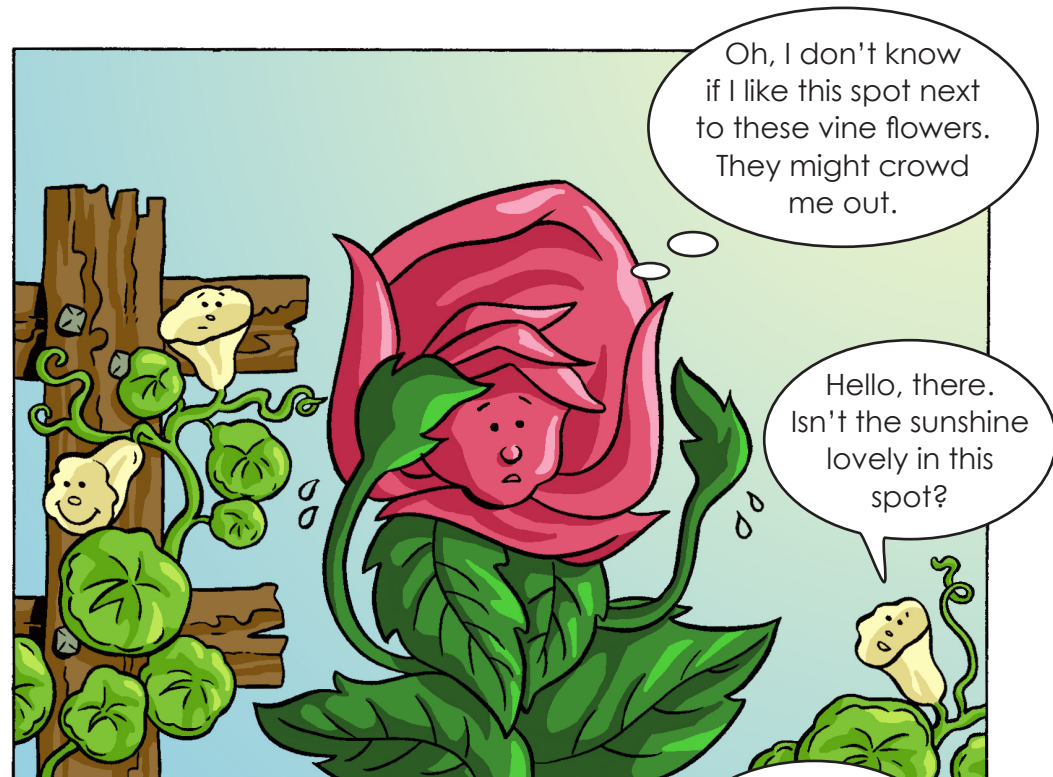
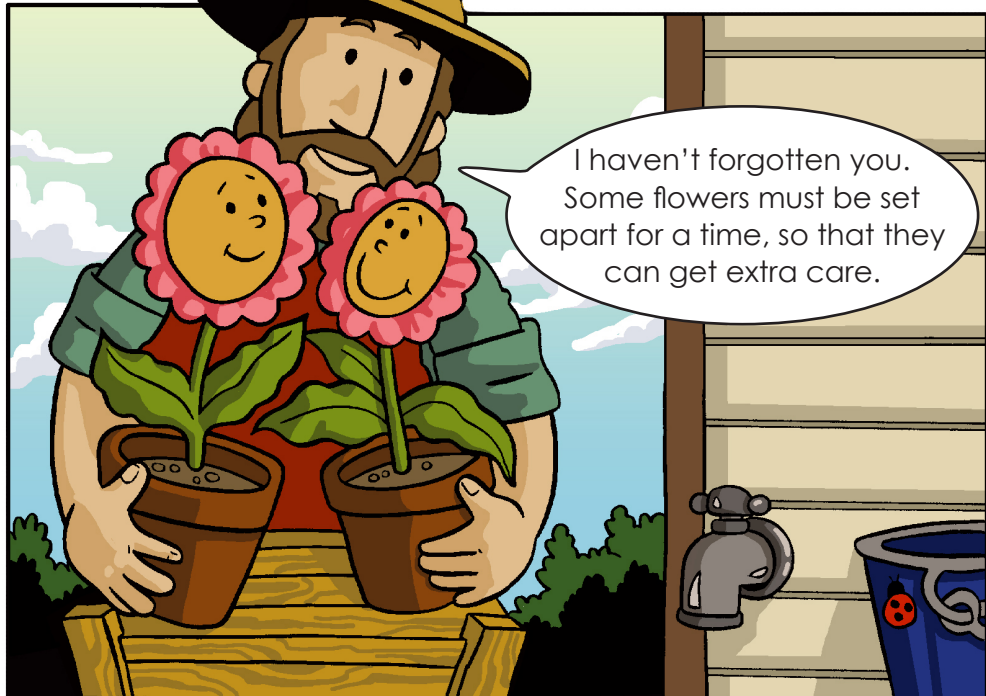
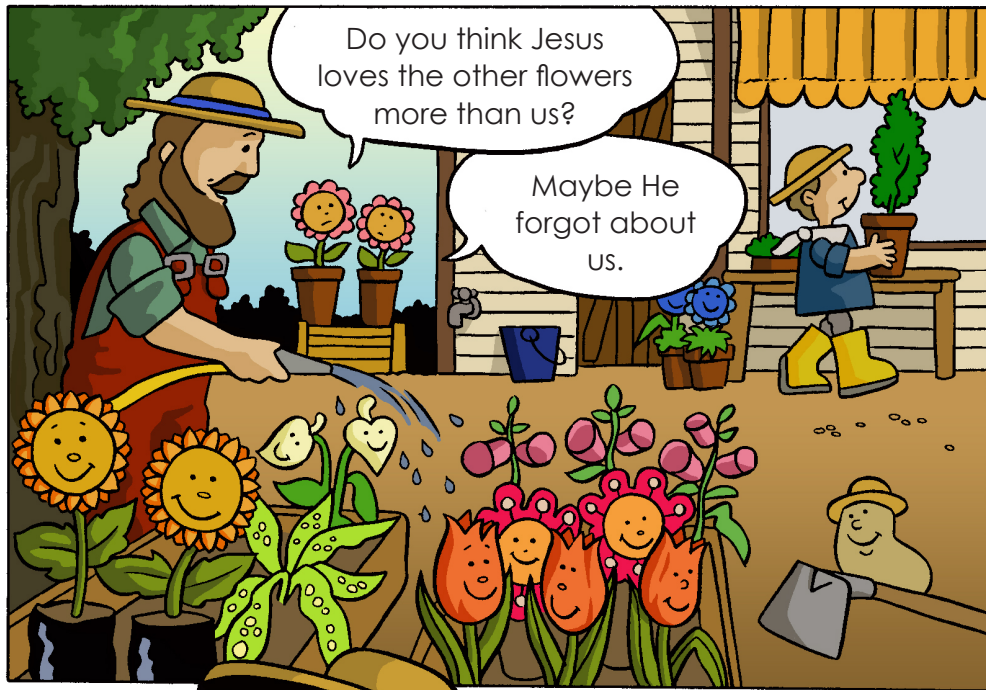


Some of the flowers in the garden are unhappy, and I don't know how to help them.
