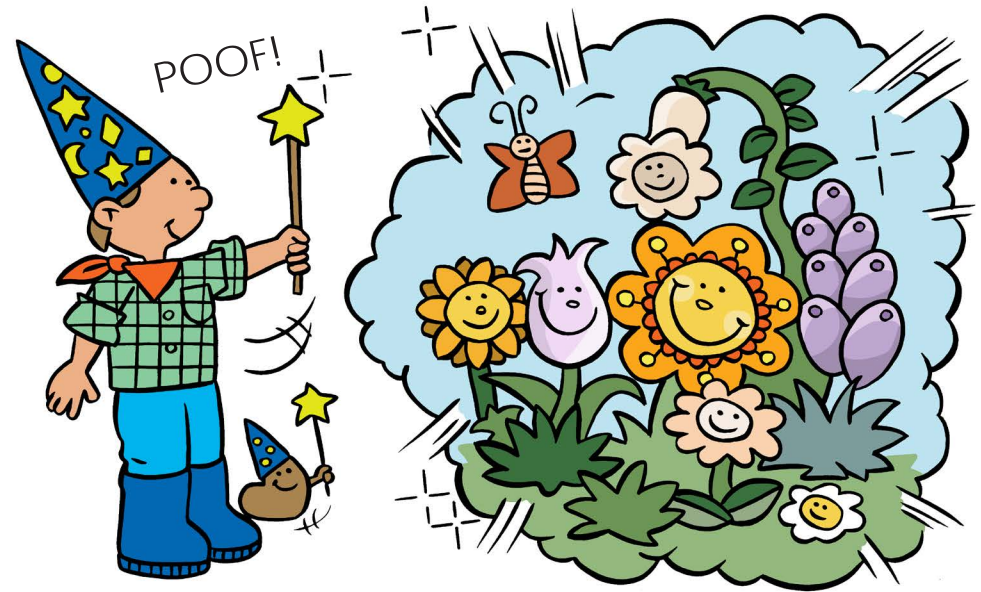




When you are working with others on something, it is important to work as a team. You may not always agree with each other, but part of working together means looking for solutions that most, if not everyone, can agree on.

Working in teamwork means deciding that you want to get along with others, even when it is challenging.

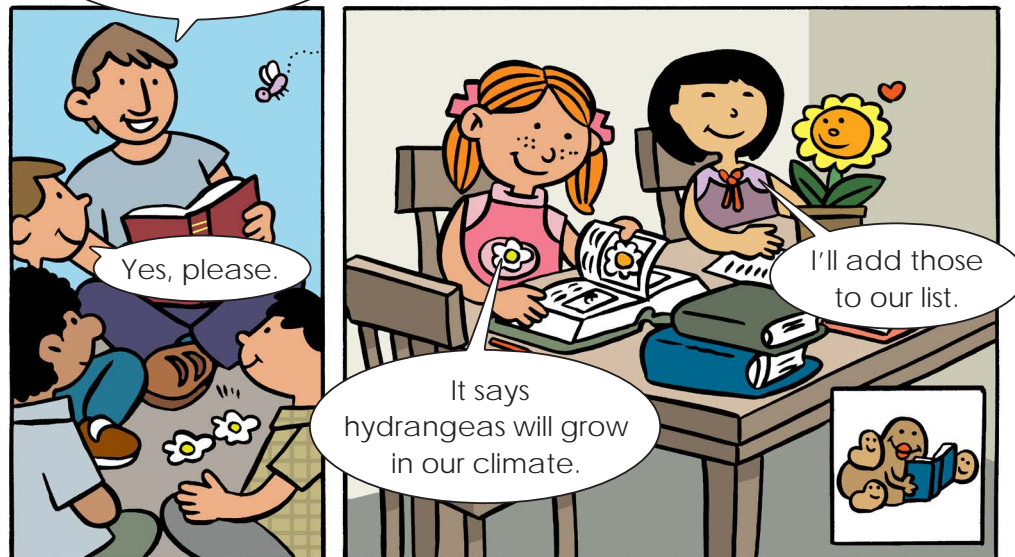


In your interactions with others, you have to plant seeds of kindness and harmony. You do this by being thoughtful in your actions and kind with your words.

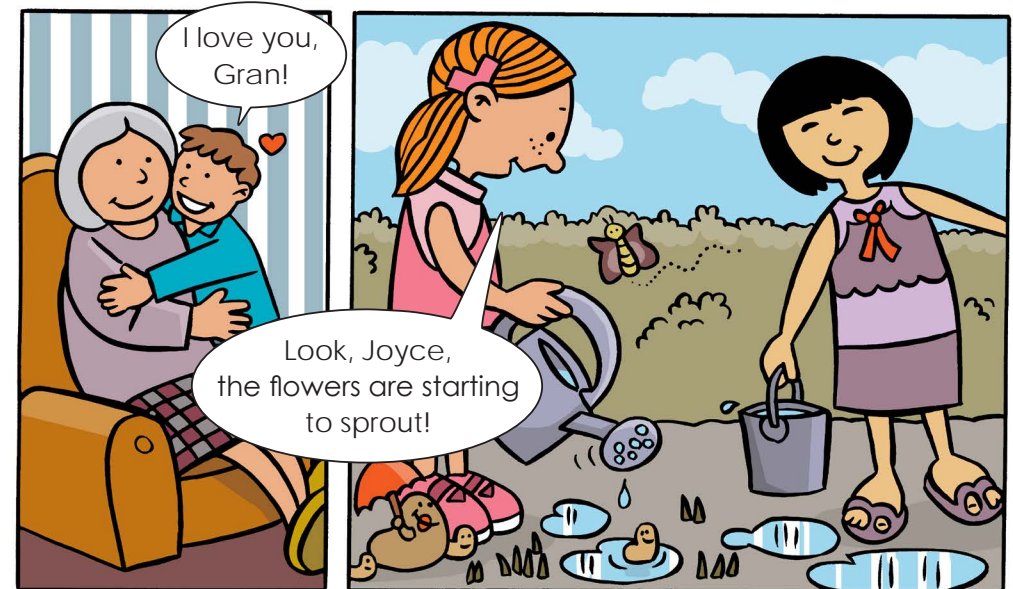


So, you are looking for information on what plants will grow here during this season?

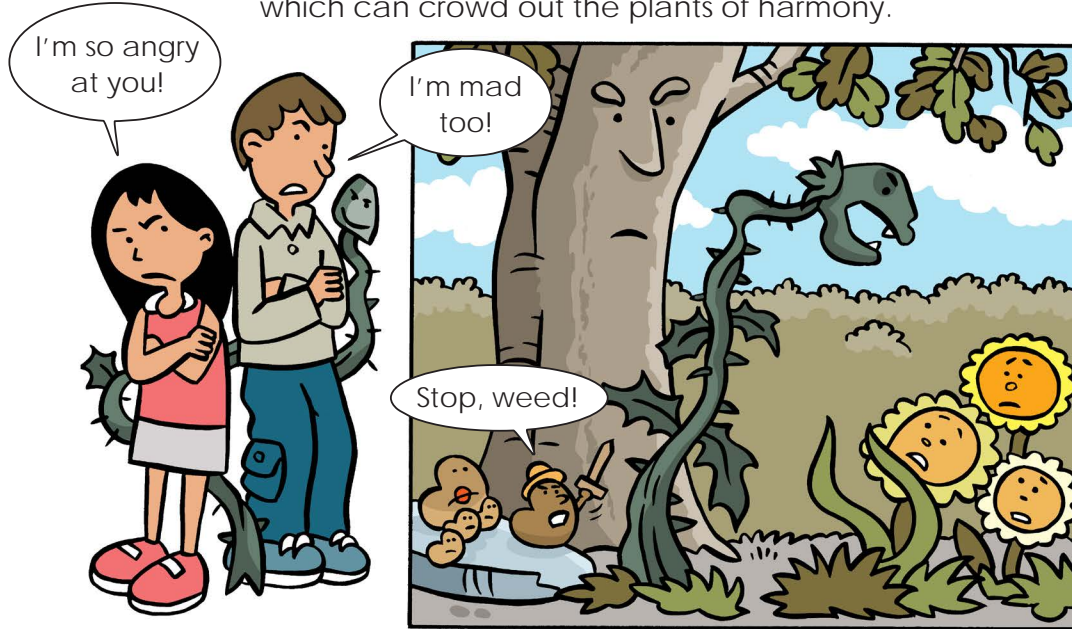
Then you need to decide together how you are going to reach your team's goals.



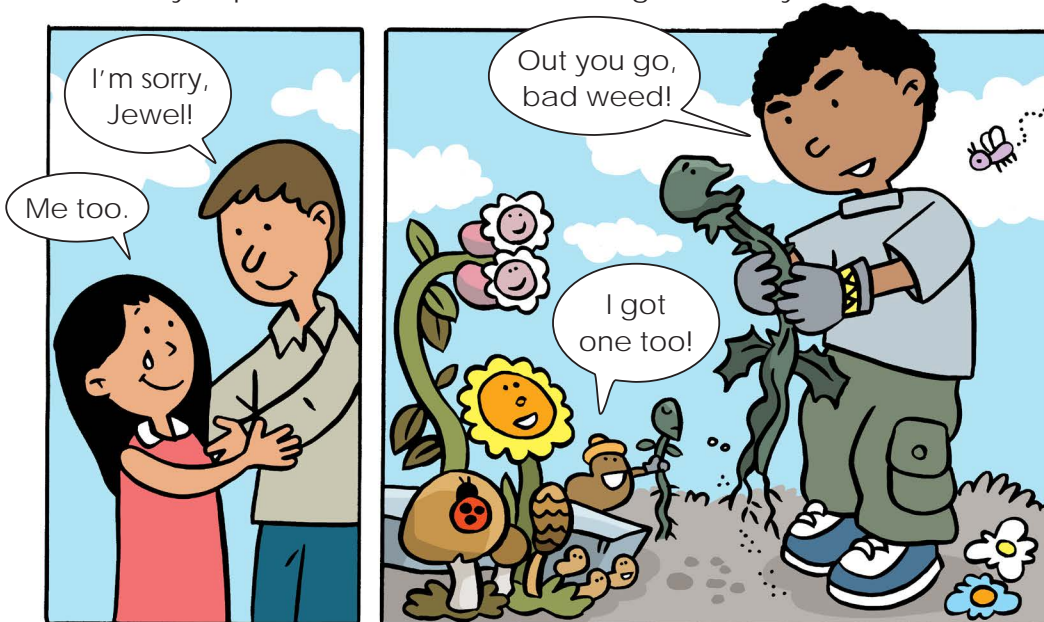
You must then water the seeds of harmony by continuing to show kindness and courtesy to others. This helps to make the right environment for teamwork to thrive in.



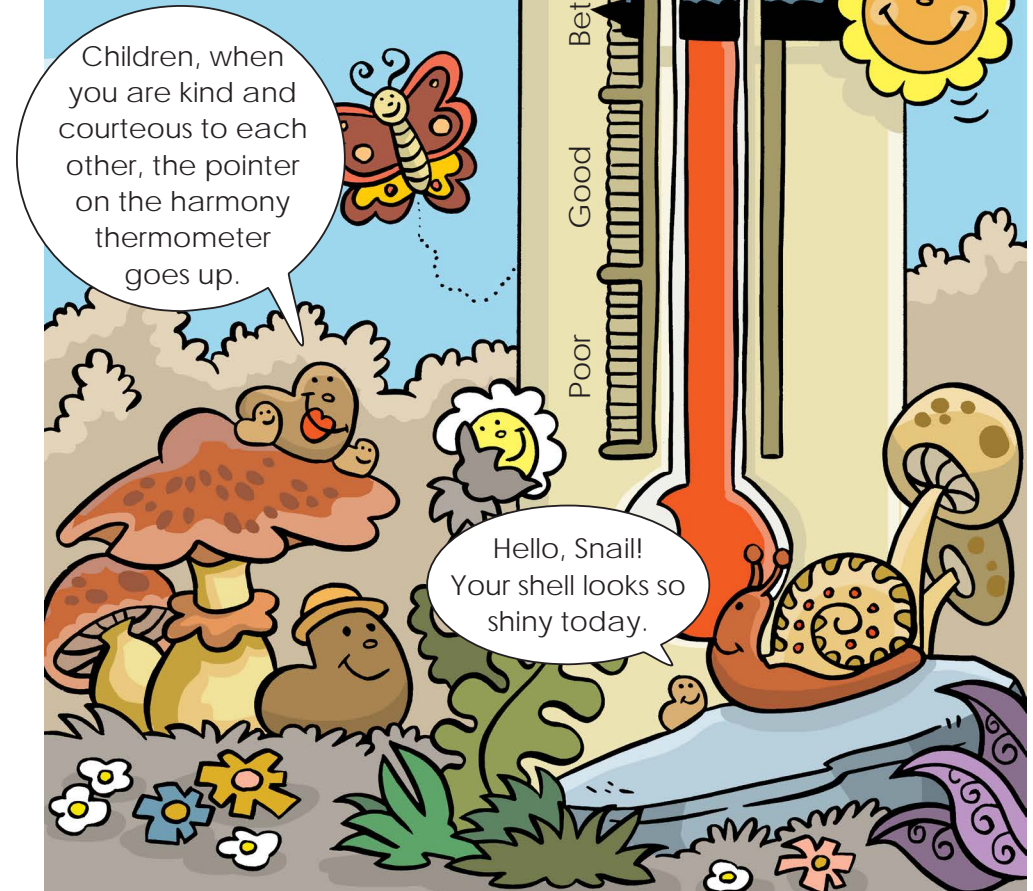
Watch out for weeds that try to grow in your garden. The weeds are unloving actions toward others and unkind thoughts and words, which can crowd out the plants of harmony.



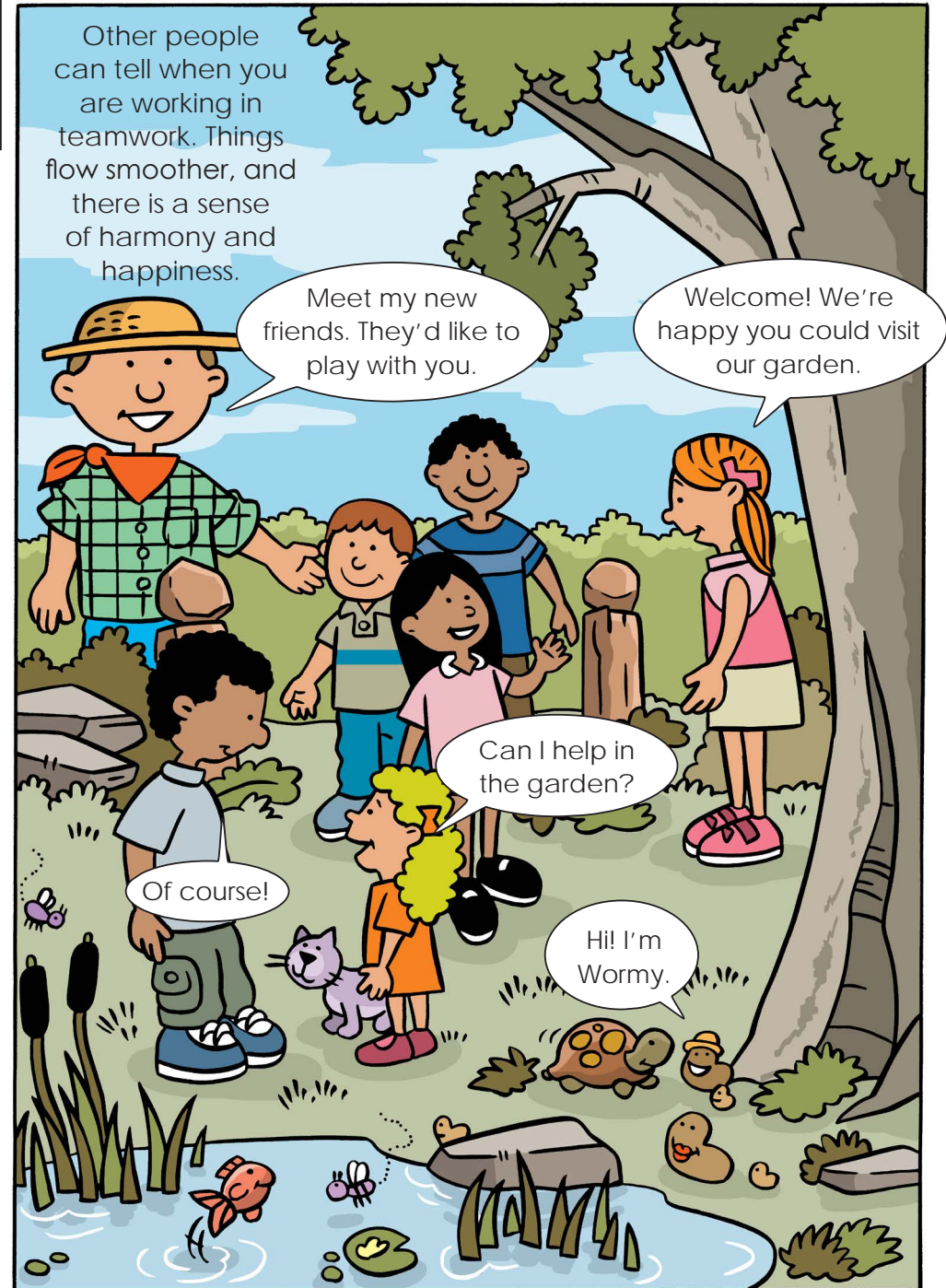
By apologizing to those whom you made sad with unkind acts or words, you pull out the weeds from the garden of your heart.
