I can be diligent.

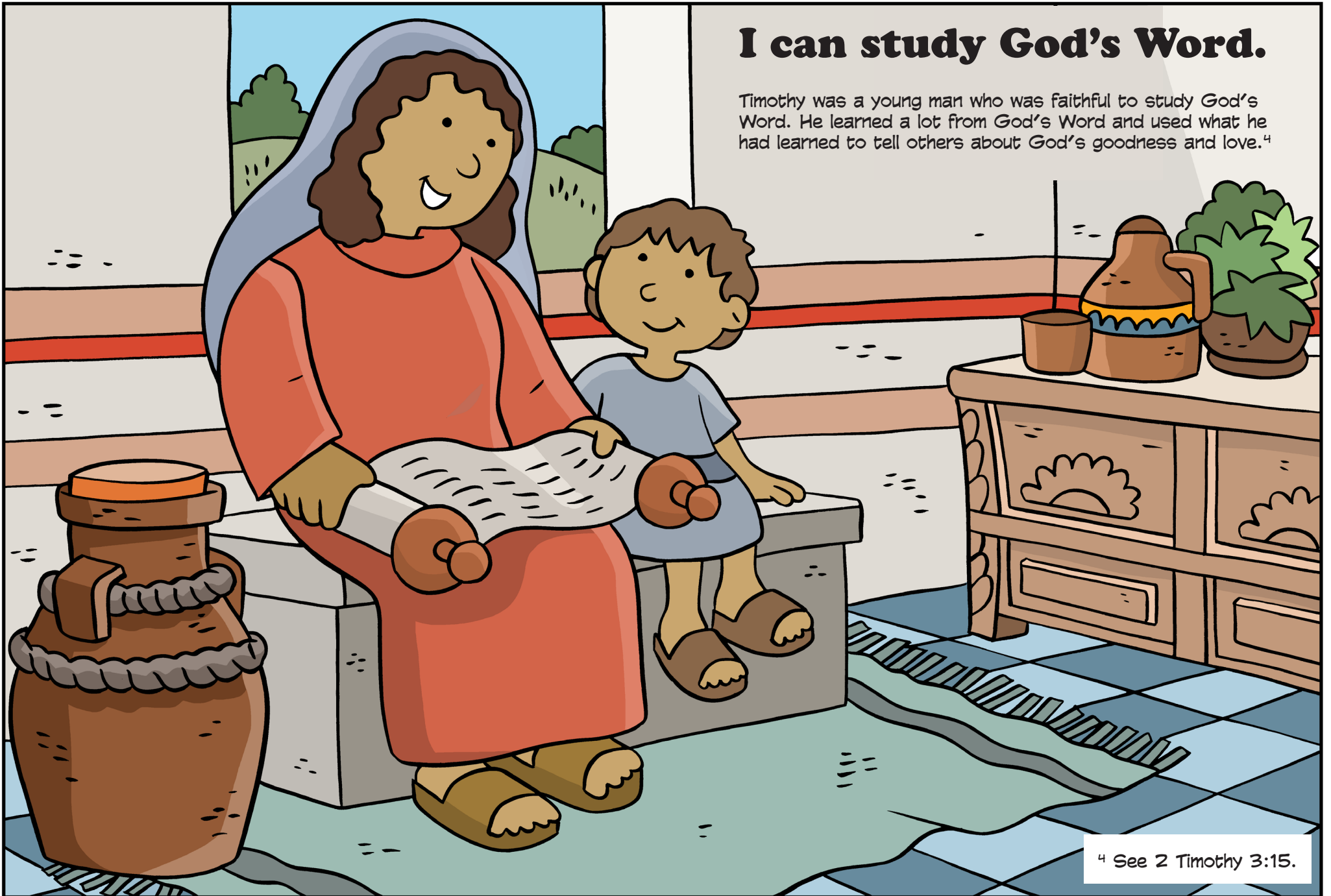
