

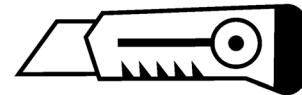
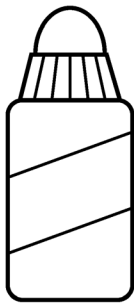
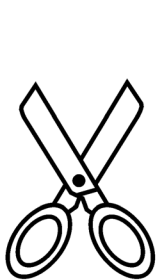
FLANNELGRAPH:

- Glue stick or white glue

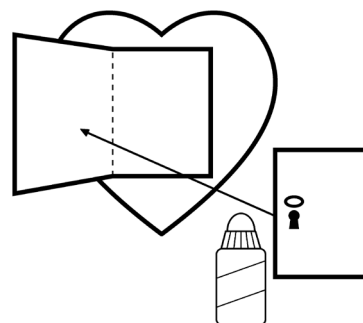
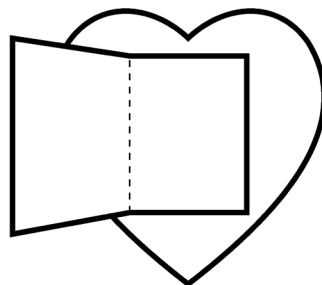
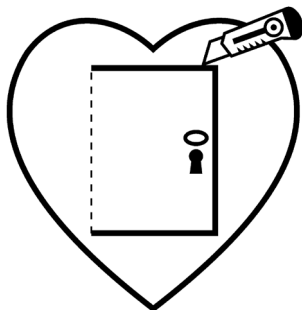
- Metal ruler to make a straight cut or score

Scoring

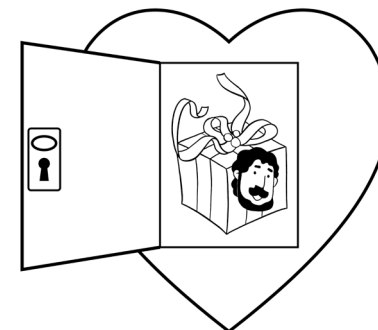
SCORE THE FOLD LINES TO MAKE A CRISP, STRAIGHT FOLD.

TO SCORE, PLACE A METAL RULER ALONG THE FOLD LINE, AND THEN PRESS WITH A DULL POINT ALONG THE FOLD LINE TO COMPRESS THE PAPER.

HOW TO PREPARE THE HEART FLANNELGRAPH PIECE



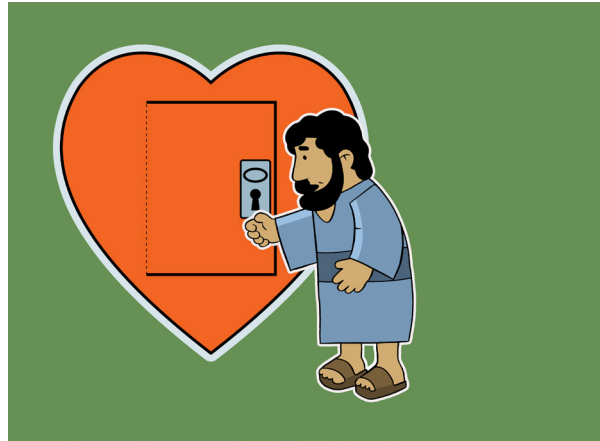

“...the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord” (Romans 6:23).



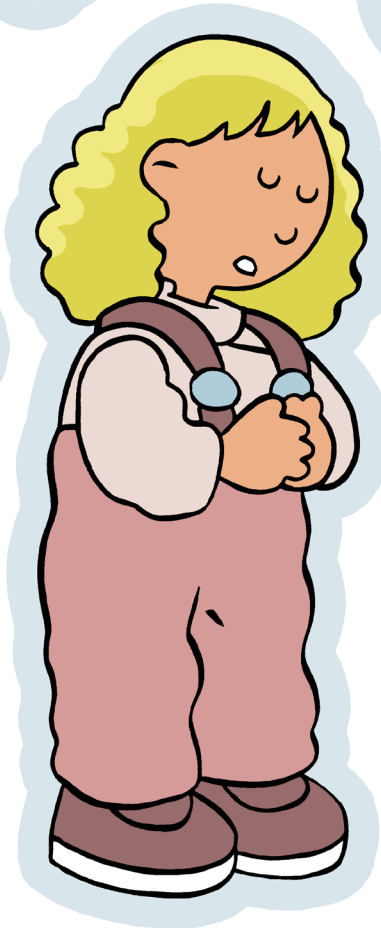
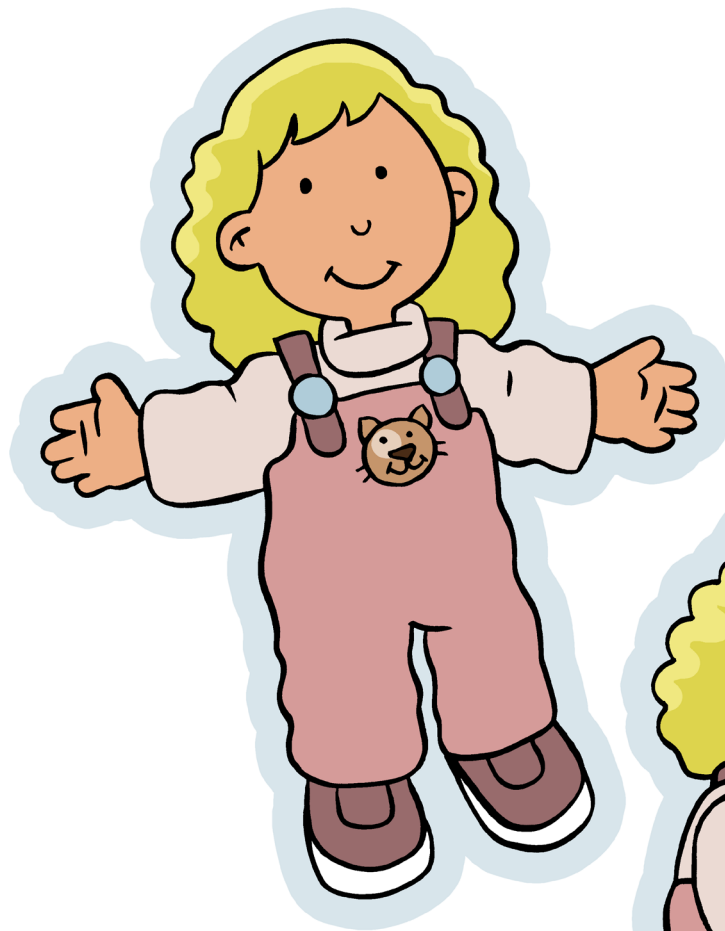
Scene 4: When we admit that we have done wrong and ask God for His help, then He can do the work in our hearts to make us more like Him. Jesus wants to be our friend and helper.

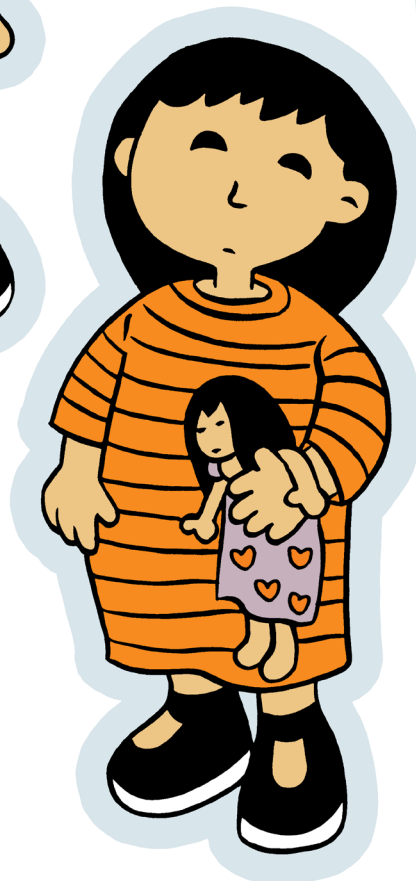
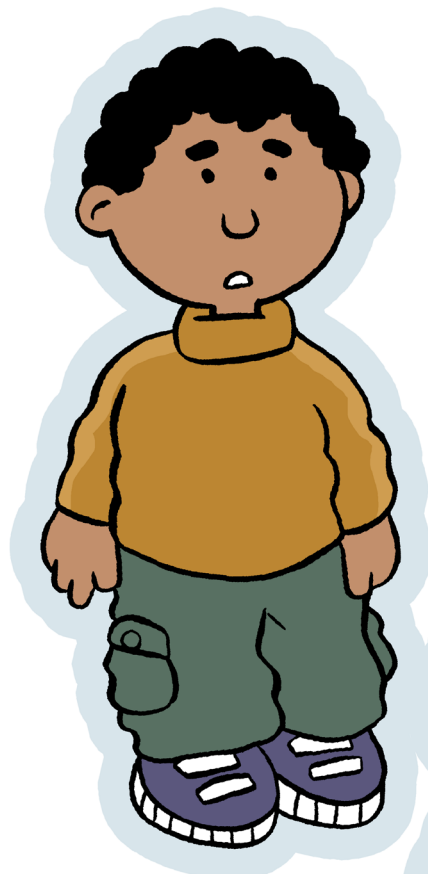

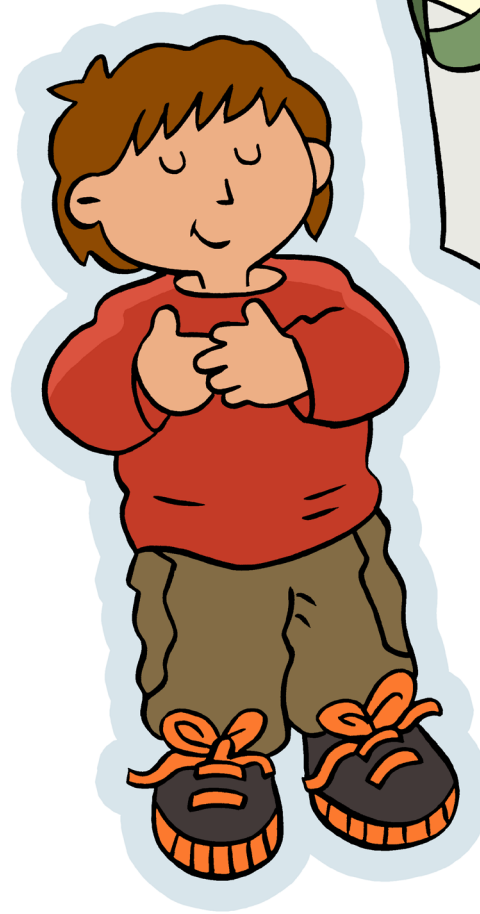
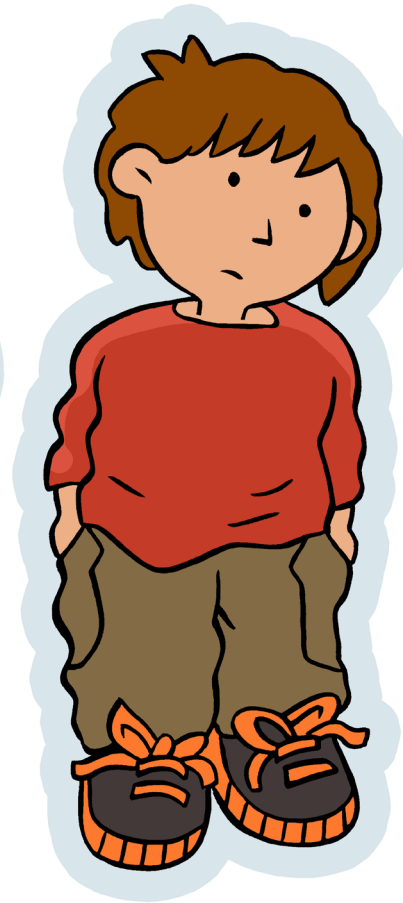


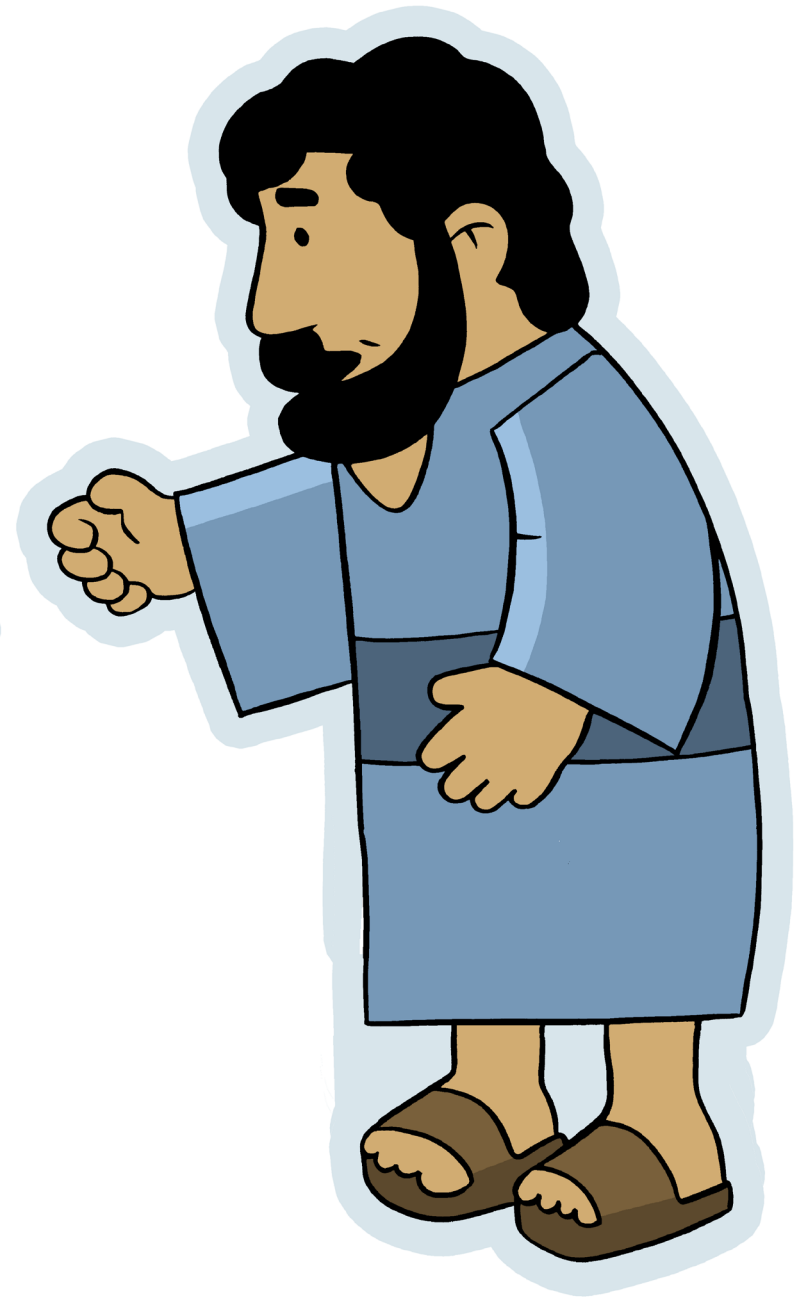
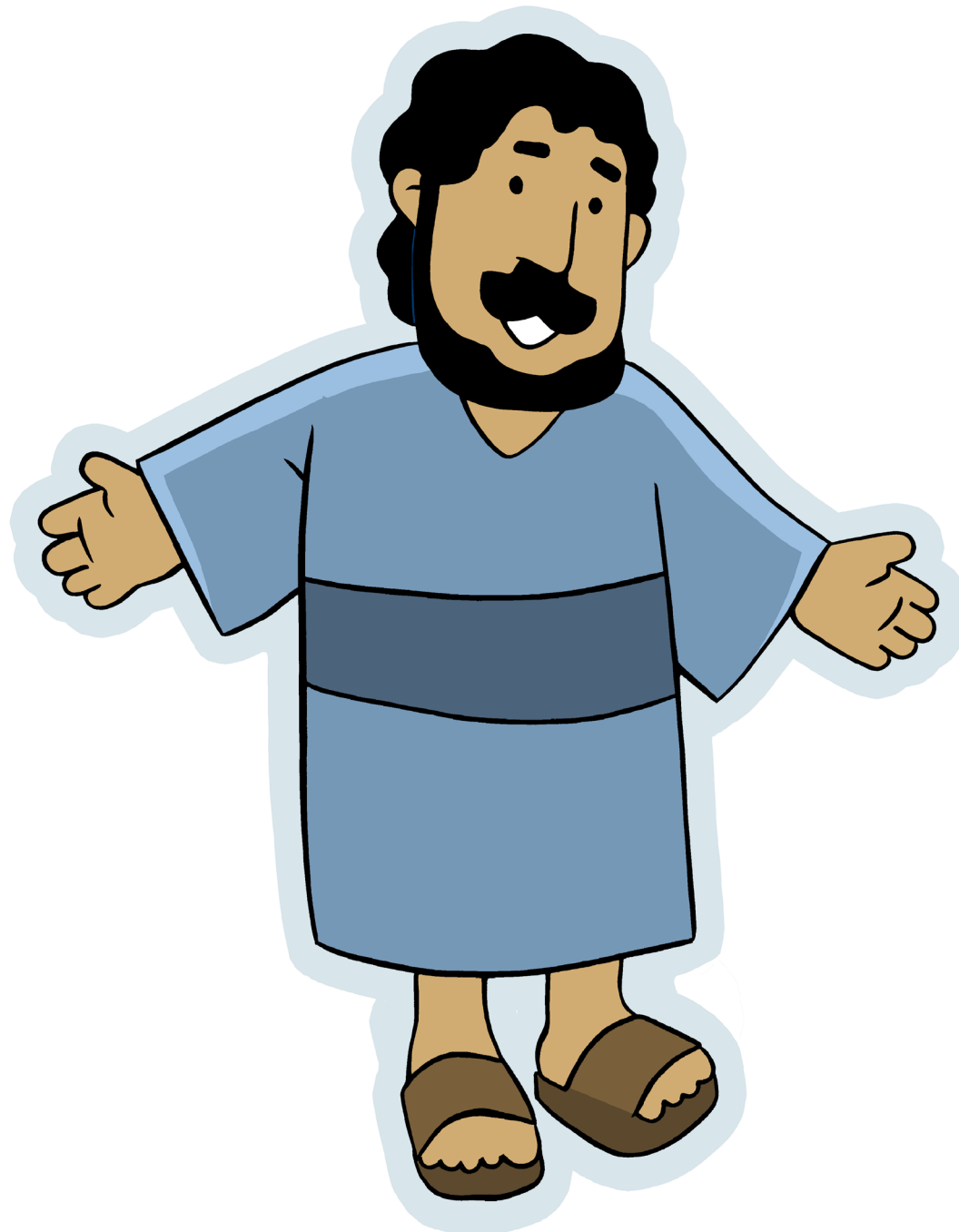
Scene 5: When we ask Jesus to be a part of our lives, then He draws near to us. He fills our lives and heart with goodness.

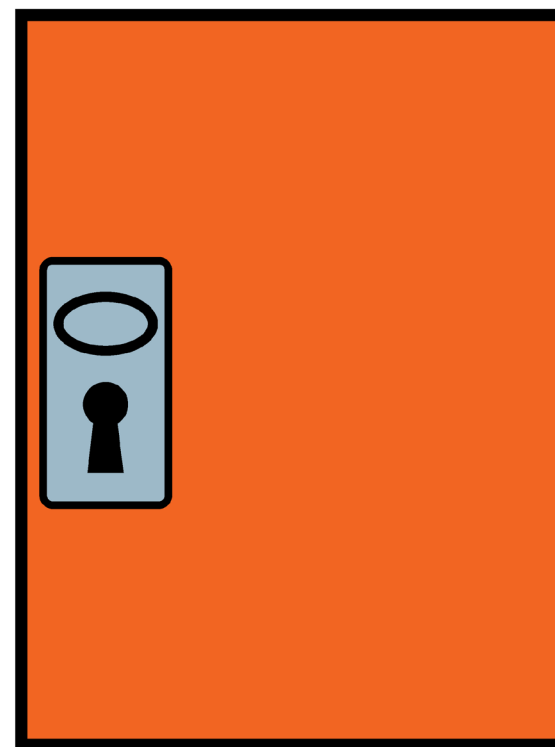
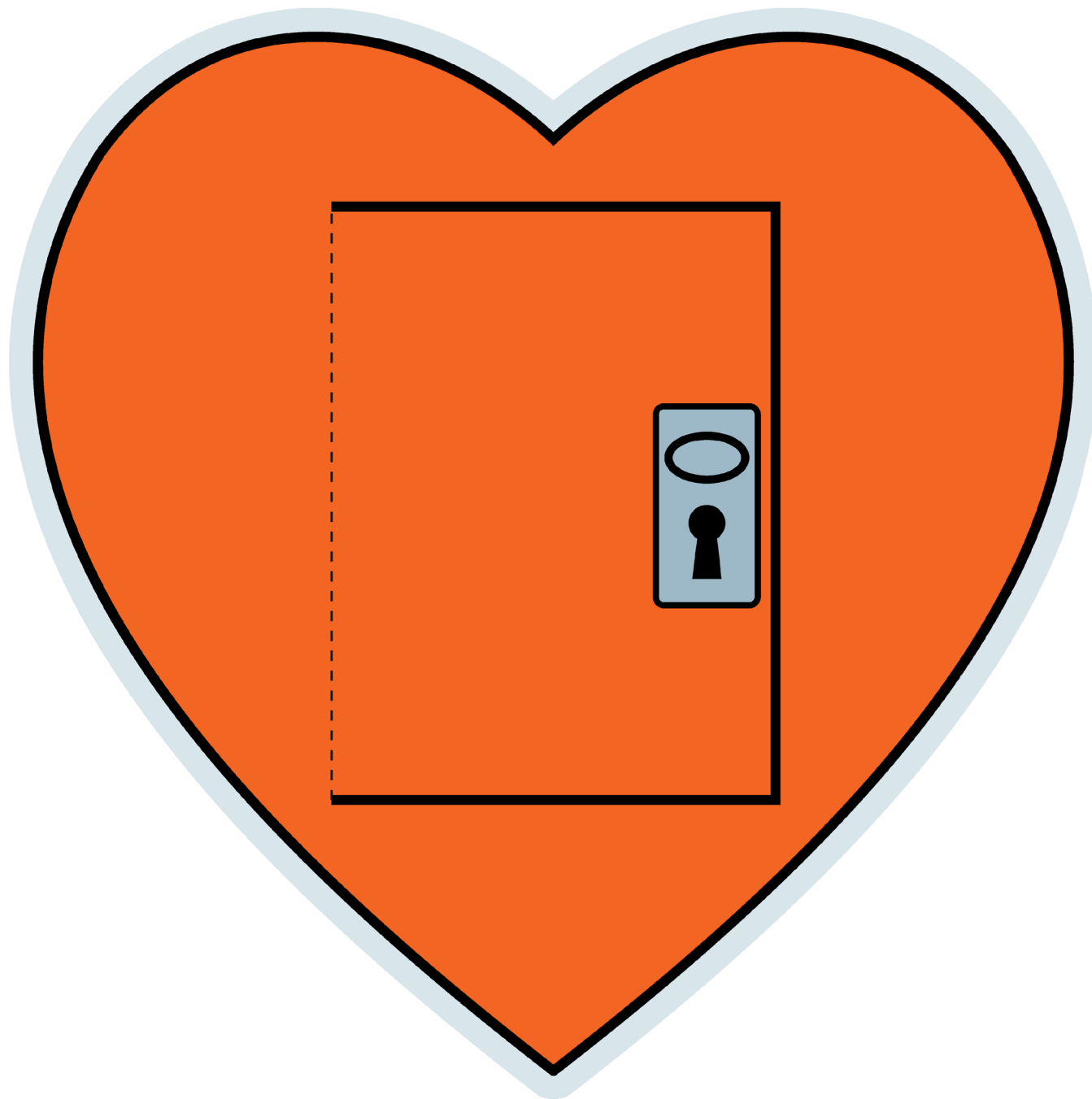

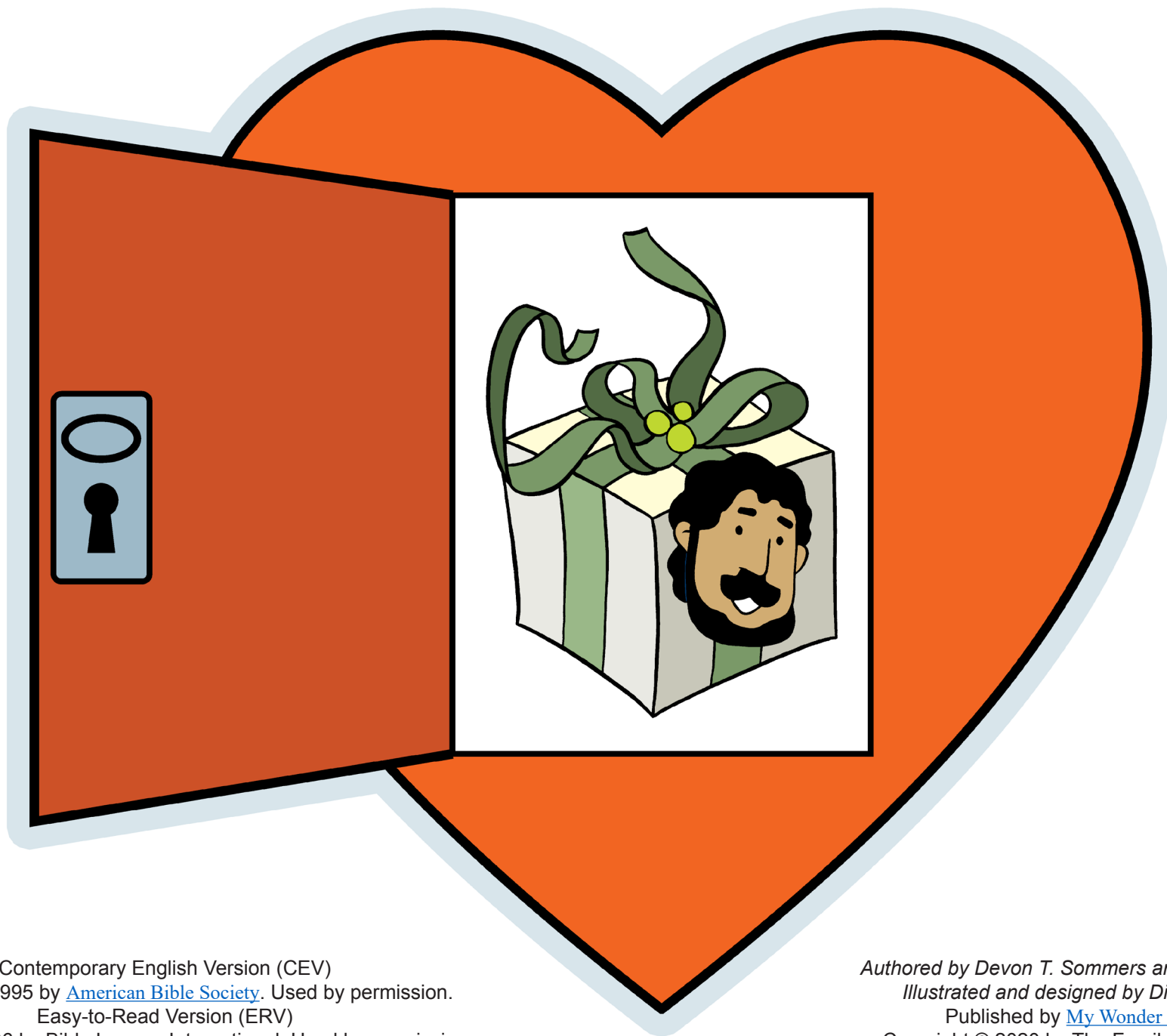
