(Psalm 133:1, paraphrased).



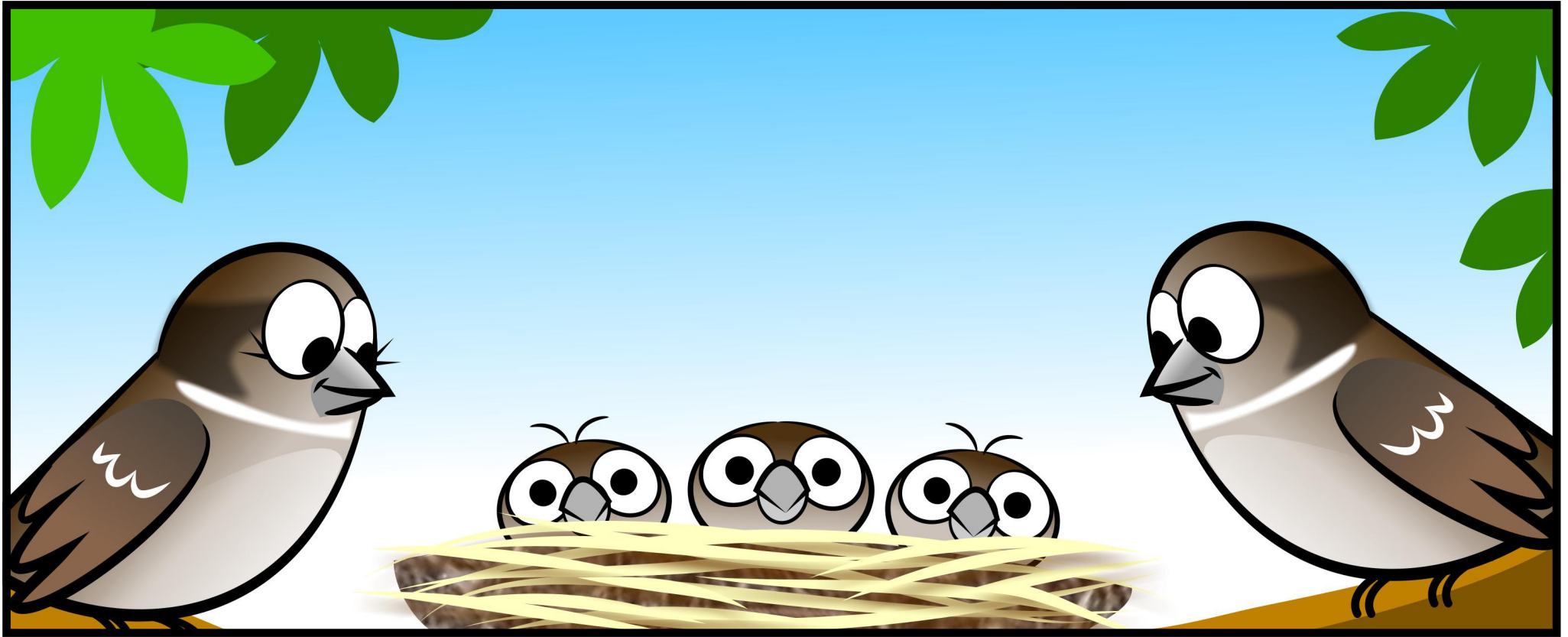
A LOVELY NEST
