Faith-filled Models from the Old Testament:
Moses

When Pharaoh's daughter found a baby boy in the river, she named him Moses. Because she needed help in caring for a baby, she had the baby's Hebrew mother continue to care for him.



Many of the ways of the Egyptians were contrary to the ways of God.

But the truth and the faith in God that Moses' gained from his Hebrew heritage stayed with him.

Moses went on to live a faith-filled life of serving God and His people, leading the Hebrews out of the bondage of Egypt and on to the Promised Land.
