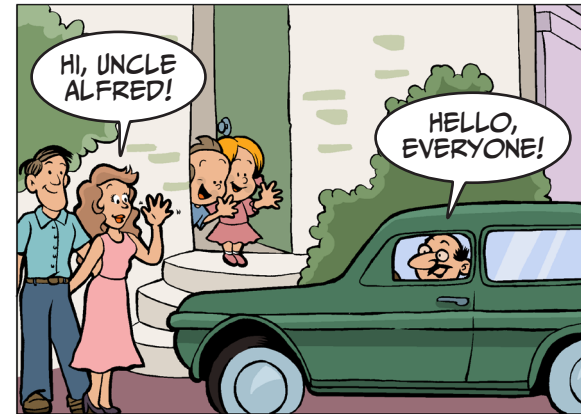
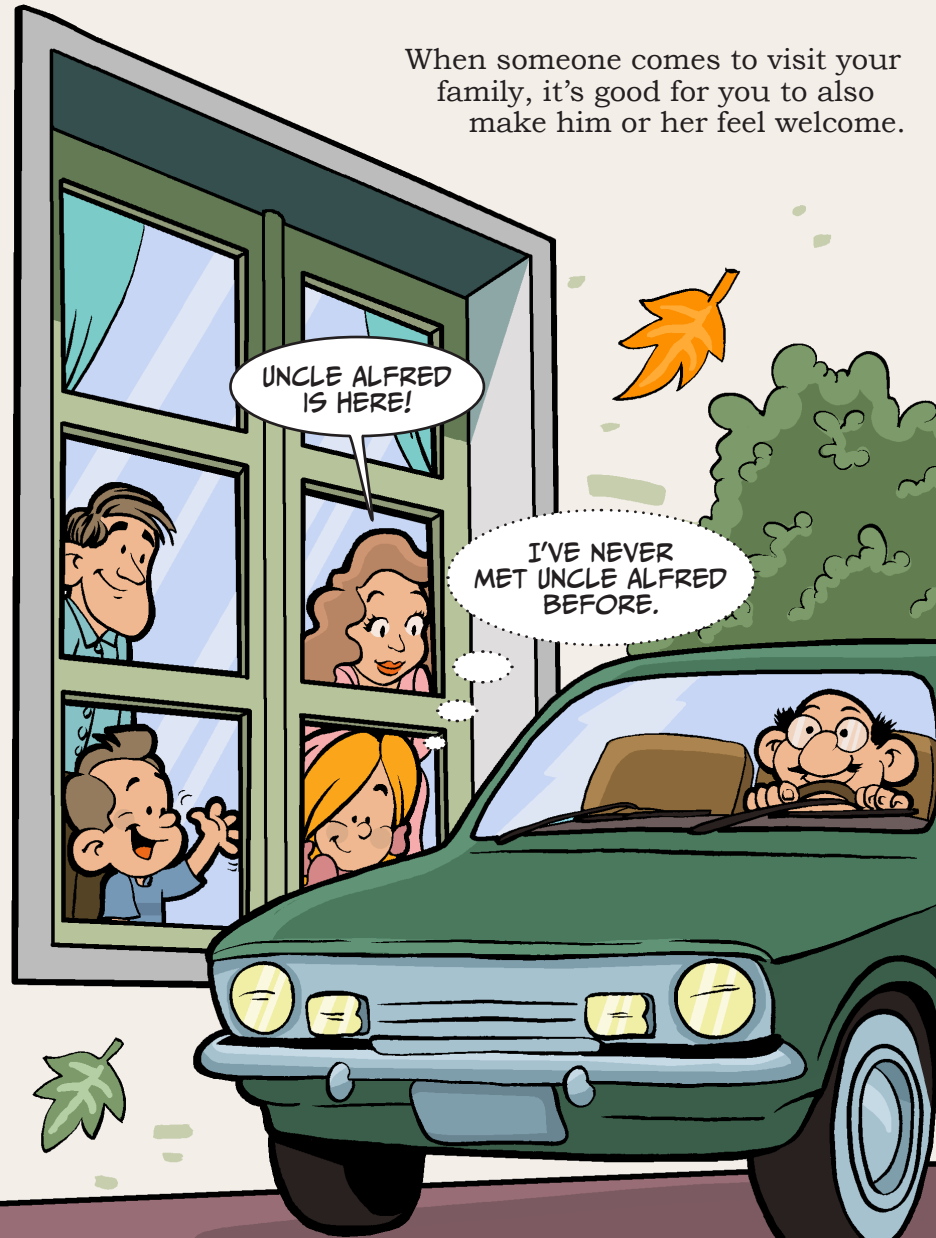
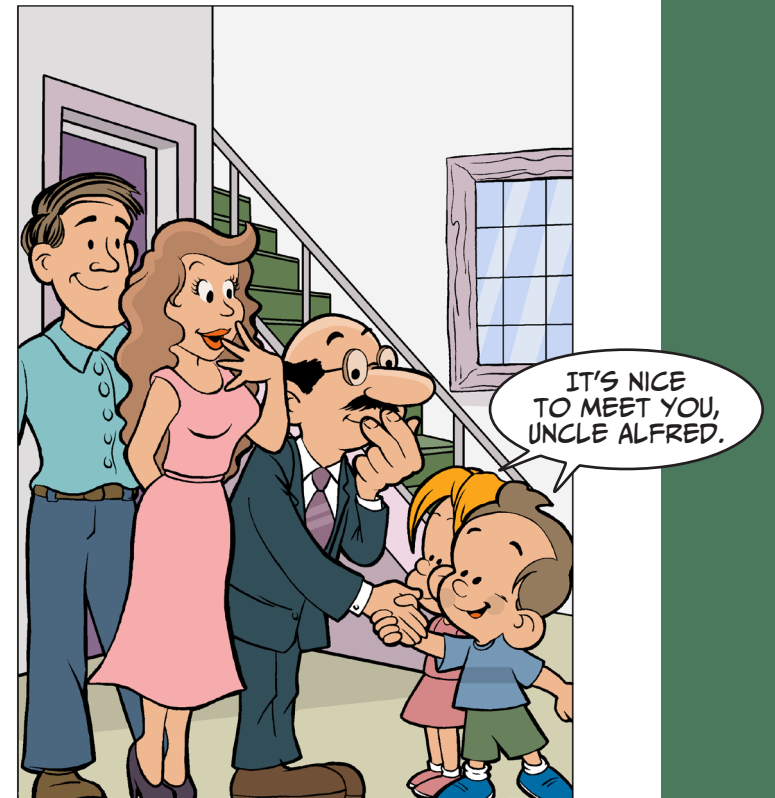


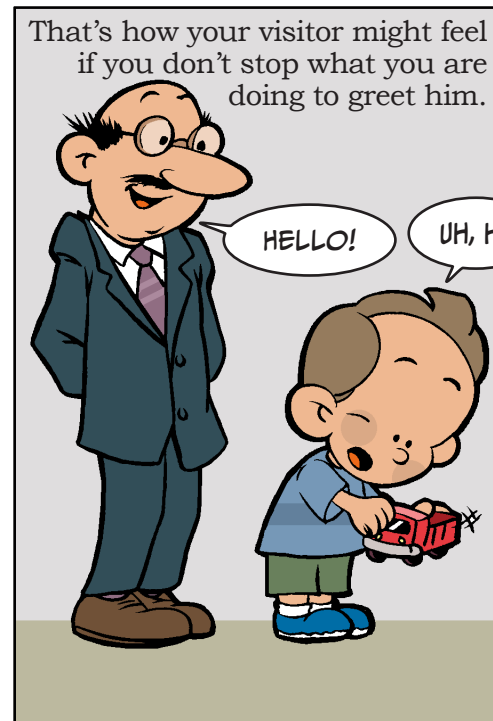
BE WELCOMING

When someone comes to visit your family, it's good for you to also make him or her feel welcome.

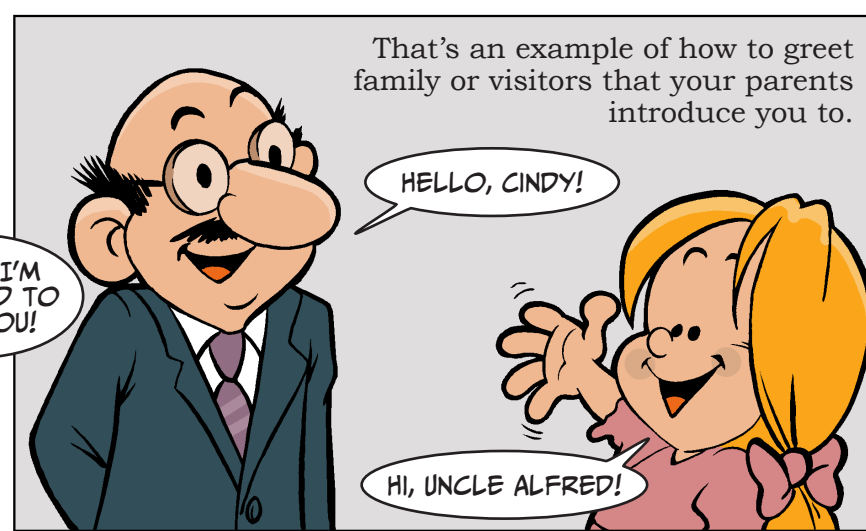
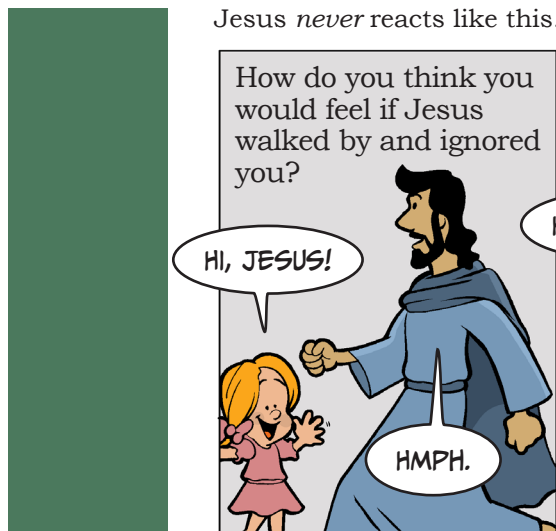


Don't ignore them, but instead stop what you're doing and say hello. When greeting someone, it's good to look the person in the eyes and smile.



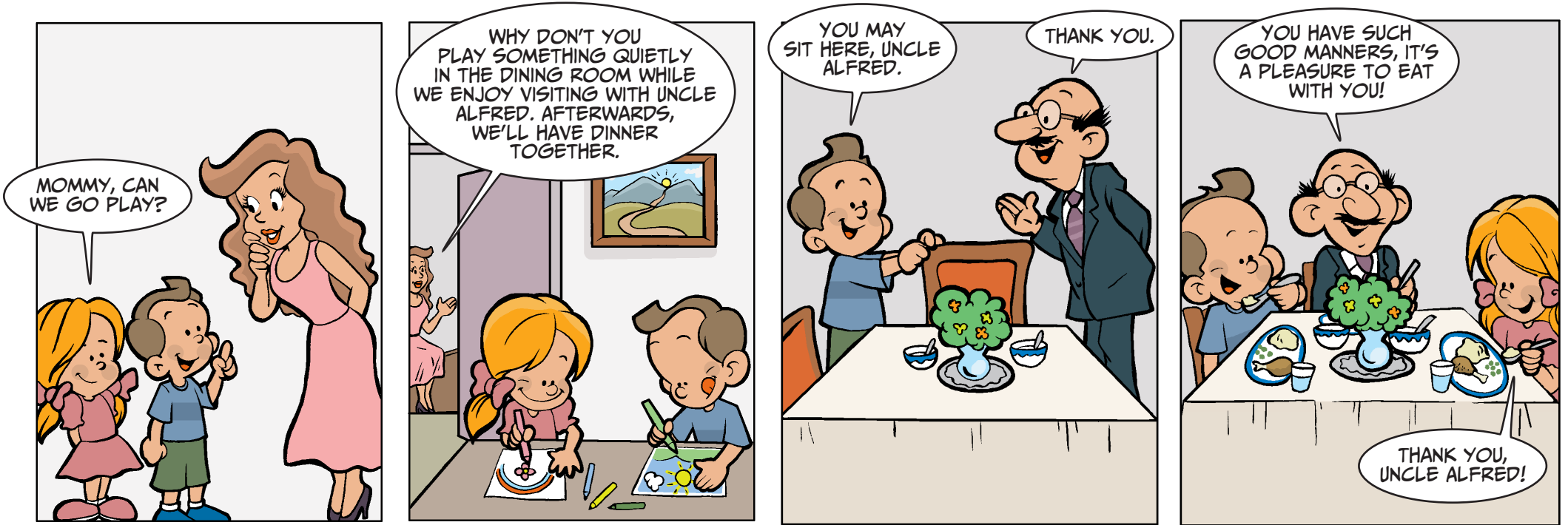

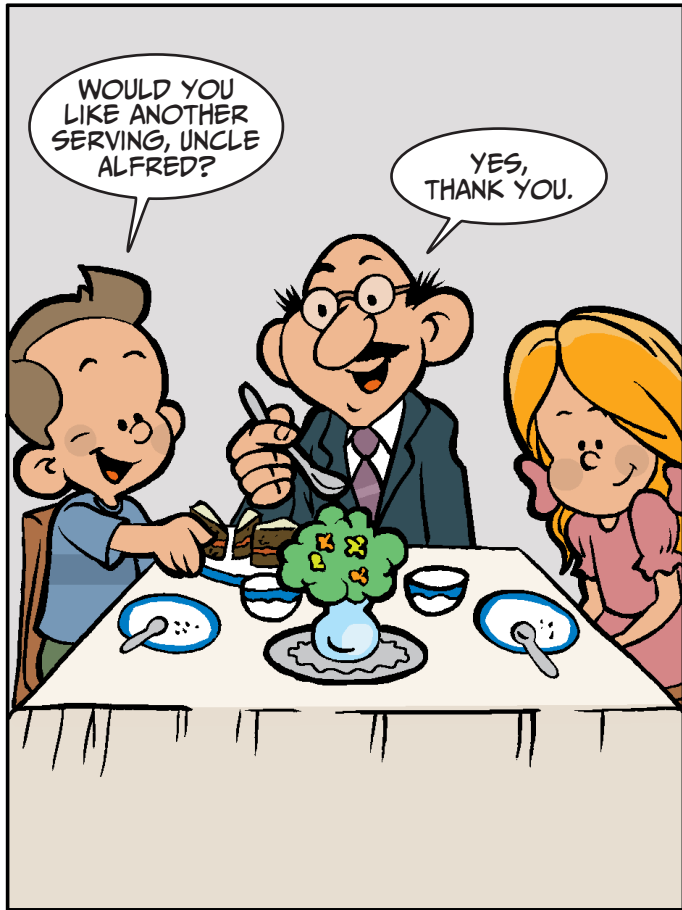
