




Play "Old Turtle" Before playing, print and cut out the cards. For 2 or more players

How to play:

- 1. Deal out all the cards to the players. (Depending on how many players you have, some players may receive one more card than others. This doesn't make a difference as to who wins.)
- 2. The players look at the cards that they have been dealt and set down any pairs they have.
- 3. Go around the circle with each player taking a turn to pick a card from the person on their right. The person the player is choosing a card from should put their cards spread out face down so that a card can be selected from their hand without seeing the cards, and the player then adds the selected card to their hand.





- 4. If the card the player takes makes a pair in their hand, they set the pair down with any other pairs they may already have.
- 5. The player who just took a card then offers their hand to the player to their left, and so on.
- 6. Eventually all the cards will have been put into sets, except one. The last player will be left with the "Old Turtle." The players to set down all the cards in their hands first are "safe."
